

An attachment-based course for parents of infants under 2 years

Right from the Start

Dr. Alison Niccols of the Infant-Parent Program and her colleagues have developed this 8-session parenting course, to enhance caregiver skills in reading infant cues and responding sensitively. The course uses attachment theory as a framework and active adult learning principles. *Right from the Start* is appropriate for parents of infants under 2 years of age, especially those at risk for social, emotional, behavioural, and/or developmental difficulties.

Facilitator Manual - includes an overview of the course, guidelines for setting up and conducting the course, specific instructions for facilitating each of the eight sessions (agendas, facilitator instructions, equipment checklists, self-monitoring forms, video discussion sheets, resource table lists, practice sheets, handouts, solutions to common challenges, references, and appendices).

Videotape - includes segments of parenting challenges to be discussed by parents in the course.
